- 5 Field trips are for 1st thru 5th grade students, although field trips maybe offered to younger children.

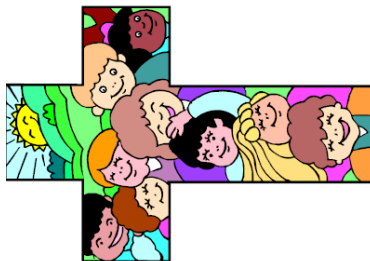
6 Bus will leave promptly for each field trip, so please have your child at school no later than 9:00 a.m. on field trip days. We will not wait for late arrivals.

8 We reserve the right to cancel a camp if there are less than 12 students signed up.

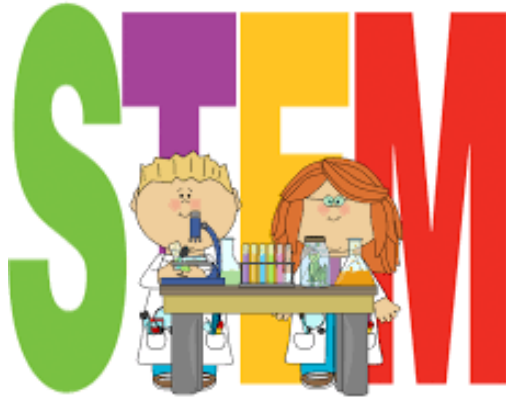
